One of the highlights of Sestri Levante is its dual bays: the Baia delle Favole (Bay of Fairy Tales) and the Baia del Silenzio (Bay of Silence). The Baia delle Favole is characterized by its colourful buildings, charming promenade, and vibrant atmosphere, while the Baia del Silenzio offers a more serene and tranquil setting, perfect for relaxation and reflection. You will be able to explore its historic centre, adorned with narrow cobblestone streets, picturesque squares, and historic landmarks such as the Church of San Nicolò, dating back to the 13th century. The Painting Workshop Vacation price is subject to change in the event of unforeseen circumstances and changes in the cost of travel and accommodation services. Should any increase in the Workshop Vacation price be unacceptable to the registered member, a full refund of monies paid will

3. Cancellation and Amendments:

Cancellations received in writing 60 or more days from the date of departure will result in a cancellation fee of \$500per person. Cancellations received 60 or fewer days before departure will result in a loss of all monies paid. There are no refunds for services not utilized while on a Workshop Vacation.
